In August, I highlighted Parish groups that were selected for lay leadership opportunities within our Parish. Listed below is the group leader status update for those particular Parish Groups.

- *Social Events Committee* - Joe Jones
- *Youth Ministry Group* – Open
- *Women's Prayer Group* – After discussions with several members of this ministry, Parish leadership has decided to eliminate this ministry as most (if not all) women are participating in the Walking with Purpose Ministry.

I would also like to address some concerns that were expressed by several parishioners when I approached them about becoming a Group leader.

- ❖ What will I need to do and for what am I responsible?

In response to this very good question, lay leaders will have to clarify the purpose of their respective ministry, organization, or program. This includes reviewing the current ministry program with team members to exchange thoughts/ideas to enhance the ministry while ensuring parish goals are met. Leaders will coordinate closely with our Director of Parish Services, Theresa Leonetti O'Connor, and other parish staff. Theresa is also in the process of developing "job descriptions" for our parish ministries

- ❖ Will I have to do all the work? – Again, this is a very good question.

All the "work" should not fall entirely on the group leader as it can and should be shared with the members of each particular ministry. Hence, this question

highlights the importance of our short-term and long-term goals for increasing the membership of each parish ministry.

Monsignor Michael McCormac, Theresa Leonetti O'Connor and I express our gratitude to Dianne Tufo and Joe Jones for accepting the invitation to lead the Camp Cabrini Committee and the Social Events Committee respectively, and we also thank all our other current group leaders. ## Scripture Readings:

### First Sunday of Advent



#### First Reading ~ Isaiah 11:1-10

The prophet Isaiah lived 750 years before Christ. Despite the political unrest of that period, he looked forward to a kingdom so wonderful that even nature would be at peace. A descendant of King David would rule the perfect world. (As you listen to this reading, know that “Jesse” is the name of David’s father.)

#### Second Reading ~ Romans 15:4-9

In the early days of the Church, some Jewish converts to Christianity continued to practice their Jewish traditions. Many of them were members of the Church in Rome, along with others who were Gentiles. They sometimes found it hard to get along. As Paul nears the end of his letter to them, he encourages them to live in harmony by drawing upon the Scriptures they had in common – what we have called the “Old Testament.”

#### Gospel ~ Matthew 3:1-12

As we read John the Baptist’s call to repentance and his announcement of the coming of the One far greater than he, we are reminded that we, too, are called to repent in order to prepare the way of the Lord.

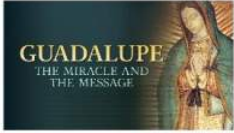
### CHRISTMAS GIVING TREES

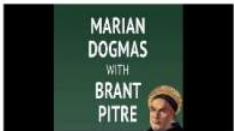

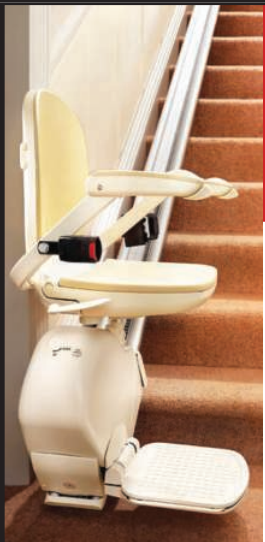
