On behalf of the Parish Staff, our PREP catechists and our Holy Family Regional Catholic School faculty and staff, I wish you a Blessed and Happy Christmas! As we gather today to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, we are reminded of our responsibility to make Him present in our lives and in our world every day! As we exchange gifts and presents with our family and friends today, and throughout the Christmas holidays, it is well to remember that God our Father, through the power of the Holy Spirit, gave to us His greatest Gift, His Son, Jesus, through the Blessed Virgin Mary. As Christians who share in the Father's gift, we are called to share the gift of Jesus with others.

Being a Welcoming Parish

Here at St. Frances Cabrini Parish, we strive to be a welcoming Parish by intentionally endeavoring to be Christ-like to everyone we encounter. What are the factors which contribute to this endeavor of our Parish Community being welcoming? **First and foremost, it is you, the parishioners**, and therefore we ask that you continue to offer a sign of welcome through a smile or short exchange of words when you notice a new face or a new family. We encourage our parishioners after Mass to continue the conversation outside the body of the church itself, so others who are praying in the church can enjoy the time with the Lord without noise or distractions.

Another contributing factor is our **Greeting Ministry**. The ministry of Greeter offers those entering our church a warm welcome and as they leave the church building, our greeters offer a bulletin and a wish for a good day. **There is always a need for more greeters**. If anyone is interested in this ministry, please call the rectory.

We also enhance our sense of welcome by assisting those who have a hearing impairment or intolerance for wheat. For anyone in our Parish Community who has difficulty hearing, we have **hearing enhancers** available in the sacristy. Parishioners and visitors are invited to simply come to the sacristy for the hearing device. Also, for those who have intolerance to

wheat, we have **low gluten hosts** available. Anyone with this particular need can also come to the sacristy before Mass and we will be sure that the low gluten host is available at that Mass. Our sacristans will be pleased to offer the simple instructions on the reception of this special type of host. For anyone who has intolerance for wheat, low gluten hosts or the wine which is utilized for the celebration of Mass, we have **mustum**.

In order to enhance a sense of welcome and to encourage fellowship among our parishioners, on the **Fourth Sunday of the month after the 9:00 AM and the 11:00 AM Masses**, we have **hospitality** in the Parish Center or in warmer temperatures on our Gathering Circle. This ministry provides refreshments, baked goods, bagels, and fruit, so that while enjoying these goodies, parishioners can get to know one another and share conversation with each other.

We are also pleased to indicate that at **11:00 AM Mass**, every Sunday morning, we have our **Little Church** program for children ages 2 through 5 in the Parish Center. Little Church is a free childcare service where the younger children hear bible stories, sing songs, and learn about Jesus along with other children their own age, while their families attend the 11:00 AM Mass in church. Parents can bring their children to the Parish Center on their way over to the church prior to the 11:00 AM Mass.

We are also pleased to note that at our **11:00 AM Mass**, we have our **Children's Liturgy of the Word** for all children in kindergarten through grade 3. Children are called forward at the **11:00 AM Mass** before the Scripture Readings begin and are sent forth from the congregation with a blessing by the celebrant. The children are led by a catechist and other volunteers to the St. Joseph Chapel in the Parish Center. During the Children's Liturgy, the Scripture Readings are proclaimed to the children in age-appropriate language. The catechist then leads the children in a teaching on the Scripture Readings. The children are returned to the congregation shortly after the offertory gifts are presented.

We are also **children friendly** here at St. Frances Cabrini. **In addition to our Little Church Program and the Children's Liturgy of the Word Program**, we offer several things in regard to our families with younger children. We now provide a family privacy room which is available in the office across from the sacristy. This room has a **changing table** and chairs for use by parents who need a place to go to change their child, nurse their child, or simply soothe their child in privacy. Also, if little ones are getting too loud in church, or need a place to go to

move about, parents can bring them to the vestibule where they are still able to see into the church, as well as continue to hear, thus continuing to participate in the Mass. We also provide **age-appropriate Children's bulletins** every Sunday at the doors of the church.

New volunteers are always welcome in these children's ministries. Safe Environment Clearances are required to participate in these ministries. Please know that the rectory staff is available to assist volunteers in obtaining these clearances.

Let us continue to be the type of community which is conscious and aware of one another, especially those who are new to our community of faith. It takes the whole community to emanate that sense and presence of welcome. Let us each do our part in the name of the Lord Jesus, who welcomed all. Let us keep in mind the words of Jesus, **"Whoever receives you, receives Me, and whoever receives Me, receives the One who sent Me."** (Matthew 10:40)

First Reading ~ Isaiah 9:1-6

The prophet Isaiah lived 750 years before Christ. In his time, the northern Jewish Kingdom of Israel was laid waste by the armies of Assyria. Today's passage offers the conquered people hope for a glorious future under a wonderful king. Christians have seen Jesus as fulfilling this prophecy.

Second Reading ~ Titus 2:11-14, 3:4-7

The letter to Titus was written about 30 years after Paul's death, and was written in Paul's name, a practice common in the ancient world. Titus was a traveling companion of Paul, and later was in charge of a Christian community on the island of Crete.

Gospel ~ Luke 2:1-14

Jesus comes to bring peace on earth by reconciling us to God and to one another with the power of love that casts out fear. His reign continues to break into our wherever the good news is proclaimed, sins are forgiven, and lives are transformed.




Christmas Caroling for the Homebound


