Scripture Readings:The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time



First Reading: Isaiah 49:3, 5-6

The devastation of the Babylonian exile was all too real for God's Chosen people who felt traumatized and

forgotten instead. The hope that is offered is that through their suffering, God is not only bringing the tribes of Jacob and the survivors back to Israel, back to fidelity to covenant love, but will also make Israel a light to other nations.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:1-3

In this passage, Saint Paul greets his community in Corinth, identifying himself as an Apostle, sent to testify to the message of Jesus Christ throughout the world. Saint Paul goes on to remind the Corinthians that they are "called to be holy" and that their lives are transformed by the person and message of Jesus Christ.

Gospel: John 1:29-34

This passage from John's Gospel presents John the Baptist differently from the other Gospel writers. John's Gospel presents the prophet not dressed in an austere manner or challenging people with a rhetoric of fire and doom. Instead, the Baptist is portrayed as a witness, one of many throughout John's Gospel, to testify to the person of Jesus. The Baptist identifies Jesus as superior to himself and that Jesus is indeed the Son of God.


