Scripture Readings: The Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Sirach 15:15-20

The Book of Sirach is a collection of wise sayings that help humans order their life and make right choices. These sayings have been handed on within the community. Sirach offers a series of choices, starting with the fundamental choice to keep the commandments of God.



Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-19

Saint Paul speaks of the wisdom of God which has been hidden from all time and which will be revealed in the time to come, the end time. This wisdom has been made available through God's son and in turn to those who believe and accept Him.

Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37

In this passage, Jesus replies to those who have accused Him of doing away with the traditions of the law and the prophets. He states that He intends to fulfill the law. His words are emphatic, and He employs a repeating technique to make His point by using the phrase, "You have heard that it was said . . . But I say to you." Using four examples from Mosaic Law, He offers an interpretation that goes beyond the mere letter of the law. He wants His listeners to live the law from their hearts, not just from external obligation.

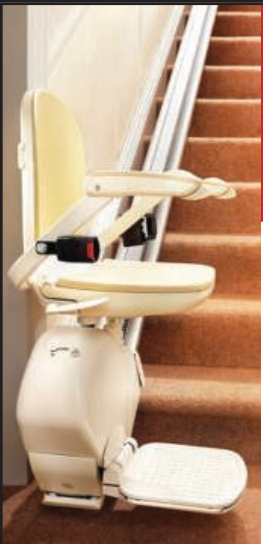
