

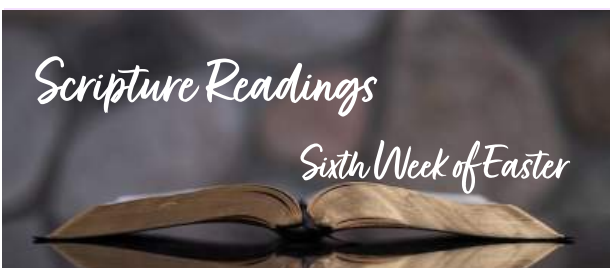
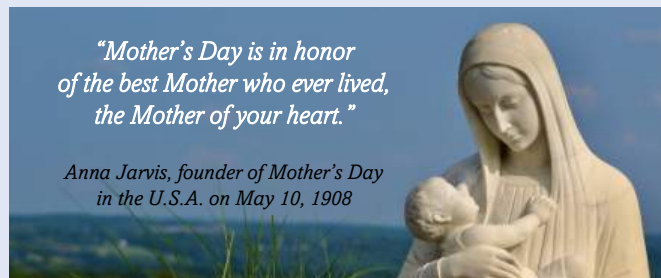

This is a big help to our local maternity homes who help our sisters in Christ through this immediate crisis with hope and practical help so that they can celebrate their gift from God and bundle of joy.

First Reading: Acts 8:5-8, 14-17

Philip went to Samaria to preach the Gospel. When the people of this region received Philip's proclamation and saw the signs performed by God through him, they accepted the Word of God and were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. The subsequent visit by Peter and John resulted in an outpouring of the Holy Spirit among the people.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 3:15-18

This passage offers a profound and succinct instruction for disciples. With our hearts set on Christ, we must be ready to witness to our hope in Him, with gentleness and reverence. Disciples must be aware that we may be maligned for our belief and Christian actions. It is better to suffer for doing good rather than for doing evil.

Gospel: John 14:15:21

Those who love Jesus will keep His commandments and in turn will be loved by the Father who will send the Spirit of truth to remain with them always. This promise means that while the world may not see Jesus, He lives in us and we live in and because of Him.

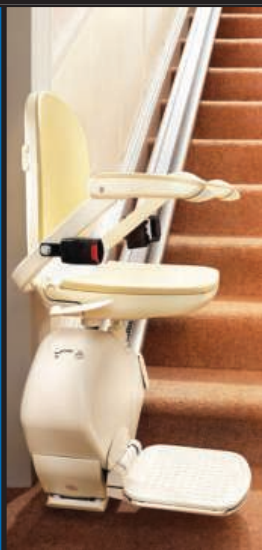
