National Eucharistic Revival

Parish Phase

Next weekend, as we join the universal Church in celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, that is, Corpus Christi, the Church in the United States will be entering into the second year of the **National Eucharistic Revival**, which is the **Parish Phase of the Revival**. As we did last year when we began the three-year **National Eucharistic Revival**, we will be having a **Holy Hour at the conclusion of the 11:00 AM Mass. Following the Prayer after Communion, instead of the Final Blessing and Dismissal, the Blessed Sacrament will be placed on the altar for adoration. Members of the congregation will be most welcome to stay as long as they wish and at 1:00 PM, we will conclude the Holy Hour with Benediction.**

Also, beginning at 1:00 PM until 8:00 PM, everyone is invited to come and spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament in our St. Joseph Chapel which is in our Parish Center. As we enter into the Parish Phase of the Revival, everyone is encouraged to make a personal commitment to spend some quality time each week before the Blessed Sacrament.

Distribution of the Precious Blood to Resume

With Archdiocesan permission, we are pleased to say that beginning next weekend when we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, we will be resuming the distribution of the Precious Blood. Although this permission had been granted several months ago, because of the lingering concerns surrounding COVID-19, it was thought to hold off for some additional period of time before resuming the distribution of the Precious Blood. And so, recognizing that it is always an option whether or not to receive the Precious Blood at Mass, **beginning on the weekend of June 10-11, parishioners will once again have the opportunity to receive the Precious Blood at weekend and daily Masses.**

New Transitional Deacon

I am very pleased to announce that Father Keith Chylinski, the Rector of St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, has informed me that Reverend Mr. Jonah A Brox has been assigned to our Parish Community for the 2023-2024 Diaconate Internship Program, which includes Deacon Brox being here at our parish on Thursdays and weekends. Deacon Brox will begin his ministry on the weekend of September 9-10.

Similar to Deacon Caleb Hile and Deacon Dominic Winter, Deacon Jonah Brox is from the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska. I had the opportunity to meet Deacon Brox at an orientation meeting at the Seminary. He is very much looking forward to meeting our parishioners and serving our community.

In his letter, Father Chylinski said that an essential component of a seminarian's priestly training is pastoral formation. He said that parish communities are chosen carefully for their ability to provide experiences and supervision that will support and assist the seminarian. Father Chylinski expressed his personal gratitude as well as the entire Seminary Community's gratitude to our Parish for our willingness to assist Deacon Brox in his formation.

Liturgy of the Word

In the first reading, God proclaims himself to Moses as the gracious, merciful, and loving God of Israel. In the second reading, Paul instructs the Corinthian community to live in encouragement, agreement, love, and peace, and ends with a blessing of the Trinity. John proclaims in the Gospel that God gave the world *his only Son*, so that everyone who believes in him ... might have eternal life.

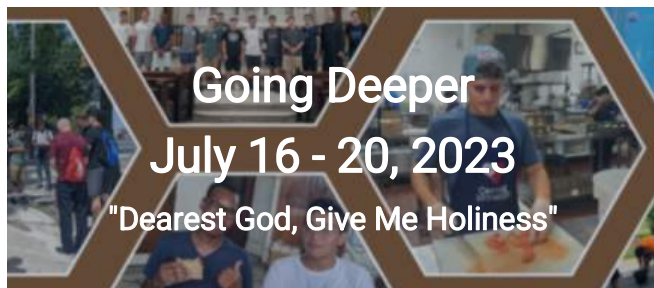

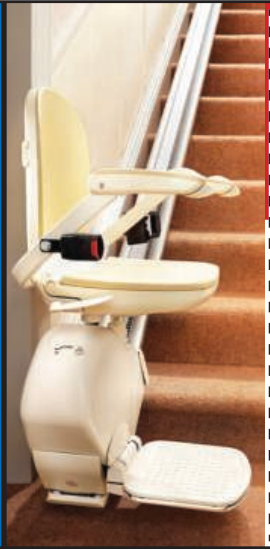
