### National Eucharistic Revival

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, the Catholic Church here in the United States begins the second year of the three-year **National Eucharistic Revival**. As we had mentioned previously, this national initiative has been called for by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. It was during their fall 2021 meeting that the Bishops decided on this National Eucharistic Revival as a response to the 2019 Pew Study which found that 70% of U.S. Catholics do not profess faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The overriding goal of the Eucharistic Revival is to renew the Church by **enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist**. Bishop Robert Barron has said that the Mass is a “privileged encounter with Christ.” Over the years, Bishop Barron and other theologians and liturgists have reminded the Catholic faithful that the Mass is not meant to be entertainment. Rather **the Mass is primarily where we most encounter the living Christ**. It is where we gather to commune with Christ, the Word of God, that is, in **the liturgy of the Word**, and where we are privileged to share in His sacrificial offering to His Father, that is, in **the liturgy of the Eucharist**. Since the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), the Church has been calling for the full, conscious, and active participation of the people when celebrating Mass. Bishop Barron has said that regrettably, many Catholics simply show up for Mass but do not actively and consciously engage in the Mass. Hopefully and prayerfully, the National Eucharistic Revival will bring about a better understanding of the Mass and our proper participation in the Mass.

**As we enter into the second year of the National Eucharistic Revival, the Parish Phase, once again, I invite you to come before the Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in our St. Joseph Chapel, making a weekly commitment to spend some quality time with the Lord, deepening your personal relationship with Jesus.**

During this year, parishes, institutions, and religious communities are being asked to devote their attention to:

- 1) A renewed excellence in the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy,
- 2) Intentional catechesis of all the faithful on the Church’s teachings on the Eucharist,
- 3) Cultivation of a deeper appreciation for the Church’s Eucharistic devotion
- 4) The important connection between the Eucharist and mission.

During this second year of the Eucharistic Revival, the Archdiocese is hosting an **Archdiocesan Eucharistic Congress to be held on Saturday, September 30, 2023 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, at the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa in Doylestown**. In addition to our own Archdiocesan Eucharistic Congress in the second year, plans are being made for a **National Eucharistic Congress, which is to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana, from July 17-21, 2024**. This national gathering of the faithful will begin the third year of the Eucharistic Revival, which is the **“Year of Going Out on Mission.”**

As we mentioned in our Parish Bulletin last weekend and also in last week’s Video Message, we will be having a Holy Hour at the conclusion of the 11:00 AM Mass today. Following the Prayer after Communion, instead of the Final Blessing and Dismissal, the Blessed Sacrament will be placed on the altar for adoration. Members of the congregation will be most welcome to stay as long as they wish and at 1:00 PM, we will conclude the Holy Hour with Benediction.

Also, beginning at 1:00 PM until 8:00 PM, everyone is invited to come and spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament in our St. Joseph Chapel which is in our Parish Center. Again, as we enter into the Parish Phase of the Revival, everyone is encouraged to make a personal commitment to spend some quality time each week before the Blessed Sacrament.





**May the living bread we eat today transform and strengthen us to do Christ's work on earth.**

Today's feast is an invitation to look at our lives and ask ourselves a few questions concerning our interaction with our Eucharistic Lord. When we consume the Body and Blood of the Lord, do we let our Lord consume us? If we are in Christ and He is in us, how does it change us? Are we living our lives on earth as if we are destined for heaven?

**Liturgy of the Word**

In today's first reading, Moses reminds the people that God fed them with manna to show them that one does not live by bread alone. In the second reading, Saint Paul beautifully describes the bread and the cup as a participation in Christ, making us one body. In the Gospel, Jesus declares Himself the living bread, promising life to those who eat His Flesh and drink His Blood.

In preparation for the Feast of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on **Friday, June 16th**, the Sacred Heart Novena is being prayed after the **9:30 AM daily Mass and also today after the 9:00 AM Sunday Mass until Thursday June 15th.**

Novena prayer pamphlets are available at the Church entrances for personal use at home and is posted on the SFC website as well. If your schedule permits, please join the community for Mass during the Novena.

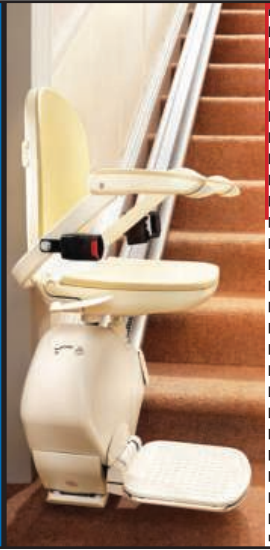
