Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary Building Our Future Comprehensive Campaign

Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, the oldest Catholic institution of higher learning in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, is calling on the Catholic community within the Archdiocese to help with securing the future of our Seminary with funds to complete the construction of the new Seminary campus and to increase the Endowment Fund of the Seminary. The Seminary's relocation to Lower Gwynedd Township is now fully underway. The plans include renovating existing buildings and constructing new buildings. This new location will guarantee and secure our commitment to forming new priests with an exceptional educational experience. Increasing the Seminary's Endowment Fund is also vital so the seminary will lessen its dependence on annual giving and ensure the long-term sustainability of the mission.

Within the last few weeks, Archbishop Nelson Perez sent a letter to those who have contributed to their annual St. Charles Seminary Appeal which is generally conducted in November. Each year, in support of this annual Appeal, a seminarian speaks at all our Masses on a particular weekend in November. At this time, distinct from their annual Appeal, the Seminary is undertaking the general phase of the Building Our Future Comprehensive Campaign.

What is being built?

- A beautiful new Immaculate Conception chapel
- A modern student life center, which will include a dining hall, contemporary classrooms, an expansive library, administrative offices, and a fitness center.
- Comfortable housing for seminarians and resident faculty

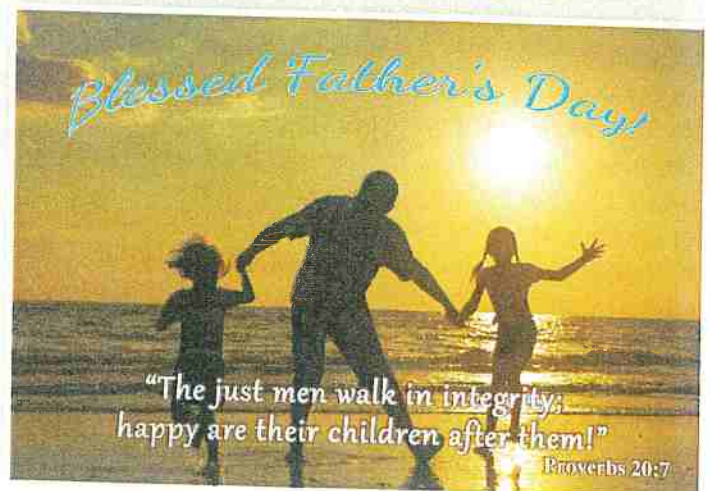
With the Building Our Future Comprehensive Campaign underway and half of the \$40 million goal already committed, the Seminary is determined to raise the remaining \$20 million to accomplish both the completion of the new seminary and to increase the seminary's endowment fund. Both of those components will fulfill the vision for the future of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary.

- The estimated cost of the construction project, including the purchase of the property from Gwynedd Mercy University, is \$54.5 million.
- To increase the Seminary's Endowment Fund to \$50 million will lessen the seminary's dependence on annual giving and ensure the long-term sustainability of the mission.

The Campaign needs to raise \$40 million for the future of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary. Again, with \$20 Million already committed, on behalf of St. Charles Seminary, I ask you to consider joining our brothers and sisters in supporting the Building Our Future Comprehensive Campaign. In the first reading, God reminds the Israelites of His care, exhorts them to keep His covenant, and promises to make them a kingdom of priests, a holy nation. In Paul's Letter to the Romans, we are reminded that we were reconciled, while we were still helpless, through Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus is moved with pity and sends His disciples to heal and preach.



The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process for adults to become Catholic by receiving the Sacraments of Initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. It is a spiritual journey centered on developing a relationship with Jesus and the Church through formation, prayer experience of parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faith. As with any journey there are stages in the process, the first of these stages is called "Inquiry" and addresses initial questions about traditions, practices and one's call from God about becoming Catholic. 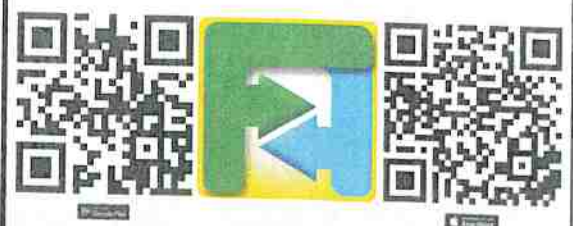

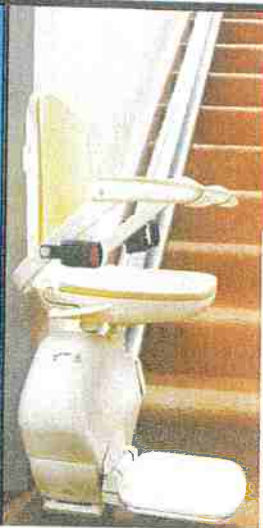

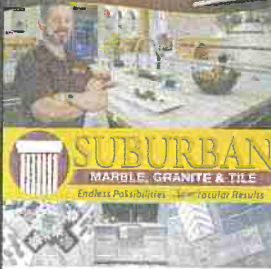
