From the Pastor



Faith Enrichment Series

It is with great joy that I am announcing that we will be having a four-part Faith Enrichment series on the Eucharist in the fall and winter. It is our collective prayer that this series will be a special source of grace which enhances our personal encounter with our Lord Jesus Christ. This initiative is flowing from the implementation of our Parish Pastoral Plan. For the past several months, our Parish Implementation Team has been praying about and discussing our Parish Community's priorities and goals. The Implementation Team is comprised of Theresa Leonetti O'Connor, John Scanlon and Audrey Wilson.

The Faith Enrichment on the Eucharist series is in response to our Parish's goal of deepening our appreciation of the Eucharist and also to deepening our understanding of the Eucharist. It is our prayerful hope that we will accomplish both of these goals.

This parish-wide endeavor will take place in the months of October and February, with two sessions being offered in each of these two months. In order to allow for all our adult parishioners to participate, each of the four gatherings will be offered three times, namely, a Wednesday evening, and also the following Saturday morning and Sunday evening. All sessions will be held in our Monsignor Woods Hall.

The format for each session will include a short presentation by Audrey Wilson followed by the gathering of those present into several small reflection groups led by two facilitators. There will be no preparation needed for any of the sessions and it will be low impact, meaning that individuals will be free to offer their personal reflections or simply listen to others share their insights regarding various aspects of Audrey's presentation from their own personal perspective.

Since the Implementation Team is giving several months' notice for these sessions, it is our prayerful hope that our parishioners will set aside the following dates in October and February, marking their personal calendars and saving the four dates so that individually and collectively, as a Parish Community, we can grow in our Catholic faith as we learn more about this central reality of our faith, enhancing our understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist, the source and summit of our Christian life.

With a desire that our parishioners will come to meet other parishioners through these sessions, when it is time to register later in the summer, we will be asking that each parishioner choose a particular day, that is, Wednesday, Saturday or Sunday, and remain with that day throughout the four sessions. The reason for this is that we want our parishioners to remain in the same small group so that they can come to know one another and, in time, feel comfortable sharing their faith and their personal reflection with the same people.
