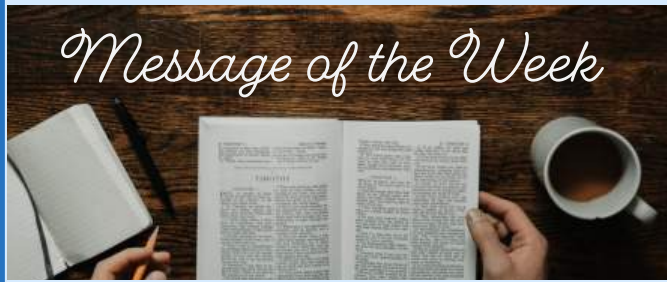

Cardinal Robert Sarah once said, "Music is a bridge between the world of matter and the realm of the spirit. It transforms our life path into a conscious spiritual path. Music takes us out of ourselves and opens us up to God." Pope St. Pius X said, "The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value, greater even than that of any other art. The main reason for this pre-eminence is that, as sacred song united to the words, it forms a necessary or integral part of the solemn liturgy."

Fully aware of the importance of liturgical music, the members of the Saint Frances Cabrini Music Ministry continue to work on our craft and to serve our Parish throughout the entire year. Our practice schedule does slow down a little in June, July and August, when we only meet once a month, but we continue to support the sung prayer of our Parish Community every weekend throughout the summer.

If you have a love for music and an interest in sharing the gift of music but were just too busy during the school year to commit to weekly practices, you are most welcome to join our choir for a few weekends during the summer months. I would be happy to meet with you at your convenience to make sure you are comfortable and prepared for the upcoming Liturgies in July. Our next choir rehearsal is Thursday, August 10th, at 6:30 PM in church. We will be reviewing the music for the August Liturgies at that time and we might even have some fun previewing Christmas music! Come and see what a joy it is to serve in our Parish Music Ministry.

The important role of music and its ability to enhance and deepen our experience of Liturgy is not limited to our Music Ministry. The Church, through the documents of the Second Vatican Council, calls all those who are present at Mass to a full and active

participation. By arriving a few minutes early for Mass, you could check out the numbers on the hymn board and read the lyrics of the hymns selected for Mass. Most often, the hymn texts reinforce or expand on the message contained in the Readings of the day. After familiarizing yourself with the hymns, you will be better prepared to hear the Word of God and to sing the hymns. Everyone is encouraged to sing out with joy, giving glory and praise to our God. You don't have to be a trained vocalist or even have the best voice; God gave you the voice you have so give it back to him with joy!

Our Parish is a welcoming Community with a rich tradition of well celebrated Liturgies. Music Ministry has always been an important element of that tradition. We look forward to welcoming new members into our choir and possibly increasing our number of cantors and instrumentalists. We also look forward to hearing our congregations making a joyful noise to the Lord by singing out with full heart and voice at every Mass.

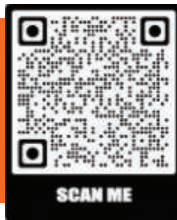
