**From the
Pastor**

**Prayerful Best Wishes to Brendan Tufo
as He Enters St. Charles Borromeo Seminary**

On December 8, 2022, I was very pleased and very proud to recommend our parishioner, Brendan Tufo, for consideration to be accepted as a student at St. Charles Seminary. Since that time, Brendan has been interviewed by the Admissions Board at the Seminary and on January 19th, Archbishop Perez accepted Brendan to begin his formation and his studies for the priesthood.

I have known Brendan since September 2008 when his parents, Michael and Dianne, registered in the Parish. In late 2008, I first started visiting Mike and Dianne in their home, then throughout 2009 during Mike's terminal illness. Very sadly, Mike died on December 1, 2009, leaving Dianne and their four sons, Joe, Vinnie, Brendan, and Marci. Brendan and his twin brother, Marci, were only four years old when their father died. As our parishioners would readily know, Brendan, and his mother and three brothers, are very active members of our Parish Community. Brendan just graduated from Conwell-Egan Catholic High School in June.

Again, as our parishioners would know, for many years as an elementary school student, and throughout his high school years, Brendan has faithfully served Mass. During the COVID-19 restrictions, Brendan served Mass throughout the pandemic, many weekends serving three Masses and sometimes all four Masses. In more recent times, he has been a lector. In a very unassuming manner, Brendan made himself available whenever and wherever there was a need. Brendan has been a "go to" person, who was always ready and willing to assist in any way needed. This faithfulness has been very reflective of this young man's dedication to the Church. He is always very respectful toward our adult liturgical ministers as well as his peers who serve at the altar. With regard to his responsibilities beyond serving at Mass, over the years, Brendan has been assisting with our Parish Religious Education Program as an aide to our catechists, most recently assisting those who were preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Brendan has also been involved in service activities here at the Parish, especially being very helpful with our annual Camp Cabrini. For the last few years, Brendan and his older brother, Joe, have



been participating in our Men's Prayer Group on Saturday mornings at 7:00 AM. Brendan, wherever he is, conducts himself in a very mature and mannerly way.

Brendan has worked at the rectory for the past several years and, along with his brother, Joe, he has also volunteered his time as a sacristan for our weekend liturgies. Through his liturgical ministries here at St.

Frances Cabrini and also his participating in extracurricular activities at Conwell-Egan Catholic High School, serving Mass there and participating in bible studies, Brendan has been and continues to be a wonderful witness to his peers. Brendan's faith, which is very much encouraged and nurtured by his mother's faithful witness as well as by members of our Parish Community, is an inspiration to many people. Upon hearing that Brendan was entering the Seminary, no one was surprised. Without drawing any attention to himself, he simply lives his Catholic faith.

During his high school years as he was discerning his call to be a priest, Brendan actively sought out and participated in various vocation experiences sponsored by St. Charles Seminary. Having observed Brendan as he has grown in his Catholic faith, I was not at all surprised when he decided to ask for an application for St. Charles Seminary. Given Brendan's desire to pursue his vocation at this time in his life and given his love of the Lord and the Church, and his service to the Church, as I mentioned previously, I recommended Brendan to Archbishop Nelson Perez and asked that his application be accepted.

Brendan will begin at the Seminary on August 23rd. In past years, a high school graduate would be entering as a first year college student, however, for the first time, instead of beginning with an academic year, Brendan along with the other new men, will participate in a Spiritual Year and then the following year, begin his college education.

As we congratulate Brendan on his acceptance to St. Charles Seminary, on his behalf I ask that you pray for him as he begins his formation at the Seminary. I also ask our parishioners here at St. Frances Cabrini to continue praying that more young men might accept the Lord's call to the priesthood.

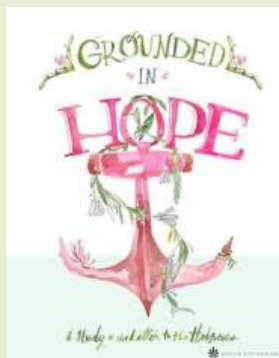

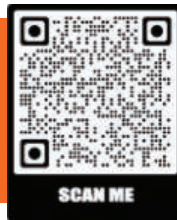
