Jean E. Madden, Director of Music

On June 28, 2018, our new Rodgers organ was delivered. For over five years, that organ served faithfully at weekend and Holy Day Masses, funerals, Baptisms, weddings and prayer services. We purchased the organ through Cunningham Pianos, the local representative of Rodgers organs. In November of 2021, Cunningham Pianos terminated their arrangement with Rodgers organs and became the authorized dealer for Allen organs. In January 2023, Rich Galassini and Tim Oliver, owners of Cunningham Pianos, made us an interesting offer. If they could resell our Rodgers organ for a fair price, would we be interested in trading our Rodgers organ for the most recent Allen model? The digital technology featured in the latest models of Allen organ was unavailable at the time we purchased our Rodgers organ and is far superior to the digital capabilities of our Rodgers organ. Through the generosity of Rich and Tim, our Parish had the opportunity to upgrade our organ to a model with cutting edge technology at minimal expense to the parish. It was an offer we could not refuse!

Our Rodgers organ is on its way to Transfiguration Church in Oakdale, Minnesota, a short distance from Minneapolis. The Transfiguration Parish was founded in 1939 and currently is home to over 1,300 households. Very similar to Saint Frances Cabrini, the life of Transfiguration Parish flows forth from the beauty of the Sacred Liturgy, drawing everyone to a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. It seems providential that as we were seeking a new home for our Rodgers organ, Transfiguration Parish was reaching the difficult decision to replace their aging pipe organ. Because our Rodgers organ is a hybrid model, a digital organ with pipe organ connectivity, it will provide a high-quality organ

console to support their music ministry as they raise the funds necessary to complete the repairs to the rest of their pipe organ.

Our new Allen organ arrived on Tuesday, October 10th. For those who attended Mass at Saint Frances Cabrini or joined us for the livestreaming of the 11:00 AM Mass on the weekend of October 14 and 15, you might have noticed there was no organ music, only piano accompaniment. The installation process was still underway at that time. We are extremely grateful to Rudy Lucente, who guided us through the entire process of acquiring our new organ, including its installation. We are also grateful to Collin O'Malley and Owen Stadele for their diligence and attention to details as the installation progressed. We offer our sincerest thanks to Rich Galassini and Tim Oliver of Cunningham Pianos for making this upgrade possible.

Rudy Lucente is a world-renowned organist. He is an assistant organist at the Wanamaker Grand Court Organ in Philadelphia, and appears regularly at Longwood Gardens in Kennett Square, PA, the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts in Philadelphia, and Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, New Jersey. Rudy serves as Director of Liturgical Music for Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Doylestown.

We are so very pleased to announce that Rudy Lucente will be the featured artist for our organ dedication concert on Sunday, November 26th, at 3:00 PM. The concert will also include performances by our own phenomenal musician, Hank Wajda, and a vocal solo by Rich Galassini. Mark your calendars now and plan to join us for the organ dedication concert on Sunday, November 26th, at 3:00 PM.

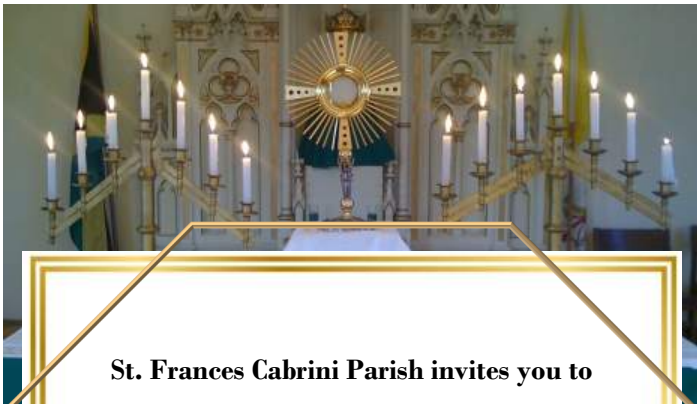

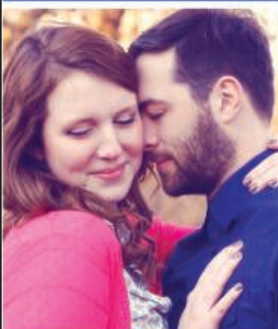
