## Walking with Moms in Need

Earlier this year, St. Frances Cabrini Parish joined a nationwide effort to increase outreach and support for pregnant and parenting mothers entitled, "Walking with Moms in Need." Walking with Moms in Need is a process whereby Catholic parishes walk in the shoes of local pregnant and parenting women in need. While not trying to turn our parish into a pregnancy center, our goal has been to learn what local centers offer, support their ministries, and empower our parishioners to know how to help moms in difficult circumstances. After about a year of work, our core team is ready to share our findings with the parish. We are so excited to tell you about the great ministries out there!

One of the first steps in this process was for our parish to take an inventory of pregnancy resources currently available in our local area in order to help us identify gaps and better serve mothers in need in our community. Our core team researched local pregnancy centers, and, rather than be content copying and pasting information from the internet, did the legwork to truly learn about each resource. We made phone calls, scheduled appointments, and visited most of our resources in person in order to better understand what they can offer a woman in need and to feel confident in recommending them. I'd like to thank all the members of the core team for their efforts: Liz Garneu, Sally Spinosa, Marie Cohen, Dianne Tufo, Dave Parker, Alyssa Bachik, Ryan

Murphy, Julie Murphy, Theresa Leonetti O'Connor, and Monsignor McCormac.

We are excited to share these results and proposed plans with our entire parish community! This weekend at Mass, there is a special flyer in our Parish Bulletin. We ask that you keep this flyer in your home so that if you ever encounter a mother in need, you know what to do. On one side, you will see three resources highlighted: The Community Women's Center in Bristol, the St. Margaret of Castello (SMOC) Home, and Catholic Social Services in Levittown. While we researched several other pregnancy support resources, we concluded that these are the first places a woman in need might turn. You can scan the QR Code to access our full inventory. On the other side of the flyer, you will see a summary of the mission of Walking with Moms in Need: Who we are, what we do, and how you can help Moms in Need in this area. Our main recommendation for helping moms in our area is to get involved with the Legacy of Life Foundation, which funds the Community Women's Center in Bristol. As you might remember from Angie McManimon's presentation earlier in the month and our Baby Bottle Drive, Legacy of Life is an incredible help to moms in need and our parish is partnering with them to better help moms in our area.

In order to expand on this information and bring our parishioners to a deeper participation in Walking with Moms in Need, all parishioners are invited to a parish-wide Zoom meeting to discuss the inventory findings, consider how our parish can respond, and offer your thoughts, ideas, and feedback for serving moms in need. 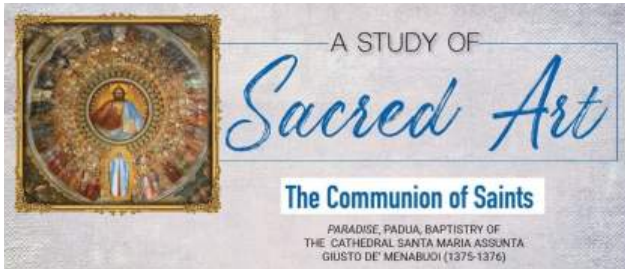

### Property Tax/Rent Rebate

Complimentary social work services are available to parishioners age 60 years and older, offering guidance, support, and practical solutions to promote dignity and independence.

The rebate program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians age 65 and older; widows and widowers age 50 and older; and people with disabilities age 18 and older. The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters, and half of Social Security income is excluded. The maximum standard rebate is \$650, but supplemental rebates for qualifying homeowners can boost rebates to \$975. Application Deadline is December 31, 2023.

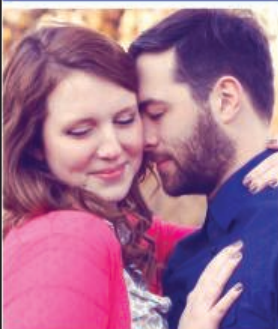
