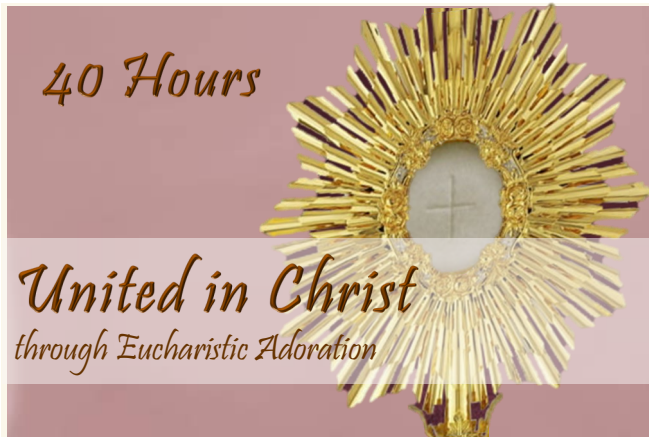

**On Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings, November 12th, 13th, and 14th, we will be having Forty Hours in our church. We are very pleased to be welcoming Father Chris Walsh who will be conducting our Forty Hours Devotions. Father Walsh is the pastor of St. Cecilia Parish in Fox Chase, Philadelphia.**

The Forty Hours Devotions will begin next Sunday morning with our 11:00 AM Mass. At the conclusion of the Mass, we will be having the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Throughout Sunday afternoon until 7:00 PM, the Blessed Sacrament will remain on the altar in a monstrance. Our parishioners and friends are most welcome to gather for their personal prayer in adoration of our Lord. Again, on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings at 7:00 PM, Father Walsh be presiding at our Forty Hours. On Sunday and Monday evenings, we will be praying the Church's Liturgy of the Hours, that is, Evening Prayer. The congregation will be praying the psalms, listening to a scripture reading, listening to a homily, praying the intercessions, praying the Lord's Prayer. Following the final prayer of our Evening Prayer, we will conclude the evening with the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Benediction is the service in which Jesus Christ is adored in the consecrated Host exposed on the altar, and in which the priest blesses the faithful with the Sacred Host. On Tuesday evenings, the final night, we will be celebrating Mass. Toward the end of the Mass, we will be having a procession within the church and then have Benediction. On Monday and Tuesday mornings after our 9:30 AM Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be placed on the altar for adoration and personal prayer until 7:00 PM at which time, we will have our Forty Hours devotions.

**For private adoration on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday, there is a signup sheet in the vestibule of the church or please go**

**online to sign up for your private adoration time. Also, our Parish Religious Education Program will not meet on Sunday or Monday evenings so that the students and catechists can participate in the Forty Hours Devotion with their families on each of the three evenings. PREP families are strongly encouraged to attend each evening, but are expected to attend as a family in place of the PREP sessions.**

At the heart of the Forty Hours Devotion is the Holy Eucharist, the very Real Presence of God among us. We believe that Jesus Christ is really and substantially present in the great Sacrament and we are especially invited to come before our Lord to adore Him, to thank Him and to intercede before Him for our personal, family and Church needs. The Forty Hours Devotion began six centuries ago in Milan, Italy and was promoted here in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia by Saint John Neumann, the fourth bishop of Philadelphia. In 1886, the devotion was approved for use throughout the United States.

I respectfully encourage all our parishioners to plan on participating in the Forty Hours over these three days and evenings. It is a most wonderful opportunity to come to worship our God who has won salvation for His people through His death and resurrection.

While we are having Forty Hours in the church, our St. Joseph Chapel will be closed and will reopen on Wednesday morning at 8:00 AM.

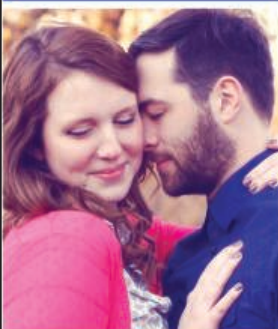
