



#### **Advent Peace**

A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths." *Mark 1:3* 

There is so much crying and mourning from so much violence and war happening in and around the part of the world that gave us Isaiah, John the Baptist and Jesus, our Lord and Savior. Instead of, "Comfort, ye, Comfort Ye, My People," we have bloodshed and bombs in amidst attempts at peace. As millions of Jewish people are celebrating the eight days of Hanukkah lights, we ourselves are in the midst of our Advent waiting in hope and this coming week, peace for Christ to come again.

As I pondered what biblical peace means, I researched the Hebrew word for peace, which is "Shalom." This kind of peace doesn't mean the absence of war, although we are earnestly praying for an end to this current war! No, the type of peace as described throughout the entire Bible is more than the absence of war/conflict but rather a deeper abiding peace in all areas of life.

Biblical Shalom refers to something that is complex with lots of pieces which are in a state of completeness or wholeness. When any of the pieces are out of alignment or missing then shalom breaks down. This includes within a person as well as with and among people and nations.

The deep abiding shalom of peace in Christ can be tricky to comprehend or to feel but it is very real if we are willing to let go of any hold or control over others or even of ourselves. The deep peace can happen even when there are conflicts and war, when we align our life to God through Christ's Spirit, for us Christians, that is, we can rest in peace of Jesus Christ.

The way to say "Peace" in Arabic is "Salam," which like "Shalom" means the same, and they are used as both greetings and good-byes today. Our brothers and sisters of Abraham, share so much more in common that I wish for a lasting peaceful understanding and genuine attempts to hear and listen for Shalom/Salam/Peace in our world.

Peace of Christ be with you all, my sisters and brothers!

ALL are encouraged to participate and share in the joy of the Christmas season.



Prepare for the coming of the Lord. Today's readings speak to us of preparing for the coming of the Lord through repentance. Repentance requires us to be honest about the times we have fallen short in loving God and our neighbor as the Lord commands. Knowing that we are sinners is a necessary step in recognizing our need for the forgiveness God has graciously offered us through His Son, whose coming into the world we prepare to celebrate.

Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11 2 Peter 3:8-14 Mark 1:1-8

Isaiah offers words of comfort and hope that the time of exile is coming to an end and the Lord is preparing to reveal His glory to all people. Peter exhorts his community to live in holiness and devotion in anticipation of the day of the Lord. Mark begins his Gospel describing the ministry of John the Baptist who proclaimed a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, and that one greater than he would come and baptize with the Holy Spirit.






