

"It was not you who chose Me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you." (John 16:15) This Gospel passage was the opening prayer for the PREP Staff Retreat this past Monday evening, January 22nd. Four months ago, the catechists, aides, office and security staff of our Parish Religious Education Program stood before our Parish Community during the 11:00 Mass on Catechetical Sunday for the annual blessing for those involved in religious education. Since then, our catechists and aides have spent countless hours preparing lessons plans, searching for games and activities. and praying for inspiration to provide the best possible experience for the students entrusted to them for faith formation. Our office and security staff have been busy making sure our students are safe and ensuring that each session and each dismissal runs smoothly. The Monday evening retreat was an opportunity for our PREP Staff to step back from the concerns and challenges of their ministry and engage in prayer and spiritual reflection.

During the retreat, we explored what it means to be a teacher and the idea of being called to serve. We reflected on our personal relationship with Jesus, individually responding to the Lord's question to His apostles – "Who do you say that I am?" We then turned that question around for some self-awareness, asking ourselves "Who do I say that I am?" We reflected on the image of ourselves that we project to others. Finally, we explored how

our relationship with Jesus and with our own true self impacts our relationships with others, which in turn impacts our effectiveness in teaching and leading others to God. It was an uplifting evening of contemplation, lively discussion, and faith-sharing.

Many members of our Parish Community will have an opportunity to experience the joy of faith-sharing when the Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist resumes in February. If you were one of the over 260 people who participated in Sessions One and Two, and you know someone who did not attend those previous two Sessions, please let them know what they're missing! Talk about your experiences. We encourage those who attended Sessions One and Two to take out your session booklet, review the content, reflect on the Points to Ponder, and anticipate the thrill of talking about your faith with fellow parishioners. We encourage those who did not attend Sessions One and Two to visit our website or Facebook page or call the rectory to register for Sessions Three and Four. The insights into the Eucharistic Prayer presented during the talks, and the personal faith stories shared by people during the group discussions, will deepen your love and appreciation for the Mass and will change the way you participate in the Sacred Liturgy. Come experience the joy of faith sharing!

Jesus taught as one having authority — having power of His own. When Jesus speaks or teaches, His words have power — for example in today's Gospel by driving out demons. In our lives, Jesus can free us from anxiety and bring us into union with the Father in the kingdom to come. Unlike all the preceding prophets, Jesus does not simply convey God's word and commands, He is God's word in the flesh. His power derives from the Father, for He and the Father are one.

Deuteronomy 18:15-20 1 Corinthians 7:32-35 Mark 1:21-28

In the first reading, Moses says God will raise up a new prophet who will speak the words of God. In the second reading, Paul contrasts the divided loyalties of married people with those who are unmarried and have only the desire to please the Lord. In the Gospel, Jesus commands an unclean spirit to be quiet and come out of a man in the synagogue.
