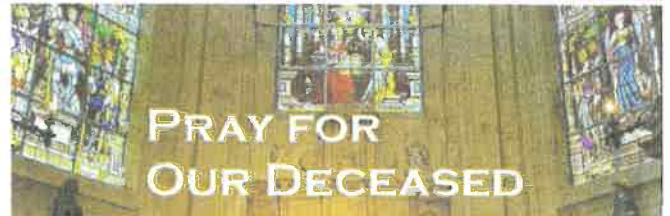

*Sunday, March 10, 2024 Fourth Sunday in Lent*



On behalf of the Parish Pastoral Plan Implementation team, I would like to personally invite you to join our Lenten pilgrimage to the National Shrine of St. John Neumann on Saturday, March 23rd.

You may ask, what is a pilgrimage? Simply put, a pilgrimage is a spiritual journey. It can be made anywhere, by anyone, for just about any spiritual purpose. For Catholics, it means traveling to a destination to experience God in a unique way.

The reason pilgrimage is such a powerful experience is because it involves leaving behind what is comfortable and known in pursuit of transformation. The goal is always transformational. Anyone can travel to a location, but the pilgrim seeks to encounter something deeper. In that way, a pilgrimage is never truly finished, because hopefully you will come back changed, unable to return to old ways of living or thinking.

It's also more intentional. It's an intentional encounter with the story of God's work in the world. Pilgrims are there to pray, celebrate Mass, and reflect on the significance of these places — to fully enter these sacred places with their hearts, minds, and souls. In the practice of pilgrimage, the pursuit of the Divine is at the beginning, middle, and end of the journey and everywhere in between.

To quote Pope Benedict, "to go on pilgrimage is not simply to visit a place to admire its treasures of nature, art, or history. To go on pilgrimage really means to step out of ourselves in order to encounter God where He has revealed Himself, where His grace has shone with particular splendor and produced rich fruits of conversion and holiness among those who believe."

- St. John Neumann Shrine has welcomed pilgrims who desire to strengthen their spirit with the Saint's witness of faith and love. The Pilgrimage includes the following:
- Tour of the Upper Church and Shrine,
- Seeing a short video of the healing of St. John Neumann,
- Opportunity for the Sacrament of Penance,
- Celebration of Mass, and
- Blessing with the relic of St. John Neumann following Mass.

The Pilgrimage will be leaving our church parking lot at 9:15 AM and return around 2:00 PM. The initial plan is to carpool. However, the Parish will provide a bus if there is enough interest. Please note that pilgrims will need to provide their own food and drinks. The offering to the Shrine is \$7.00 per person. Please contact the rectory as soon as possible if you are interested in joining the pilgrimage as we need to confirm the possible bus reservation by March 13th.

Also, each month in our Parish Bulletin, we are highlighting a Devotional Prayer. For March, we have directed our parishioners' attention to St. Joseph. Our parishioners might remember last weekend's Parish Bulletin and the insert which reflected the Litany of St. Joseph. The Church encourages us to be devoted to St. Joseph because he was a model in the heroic practice of all the virtues. The example of virtuous living that he gave in the exact fulfillment of the duties of his state of life is worthy of our reflection. Read the gospel and you will see his faith, hope and charity practiced under trying circumstances.

Now, let us pray the Prayer to St. Joseph the Worker, composed by Saint Pope John XXIII, which places all workers under the patronage of St. Joseph the Worker, and asks for his intercession so that we may regard our work as a means of growing in holiness.

"O glorious Joseph! Who concealed your incomparable and regal dignity of custodian of Jesus and of the Virgin Mary under the humble appearance of a craftsman and provided for them with your work, protect with loving power those, especially entrusted to you. You know their anxieties and sufferings, because you yourself experienced them at the side of Jesus and of His Mother. Do not allow them, oppressed by so many worries, to forget the purpose for which they were created by God. Do not allow the seeds of distrust to take hold of their immortal souls. Remind all the workers that in the fields, in factories, in mines, and in scientific laboratories, they are not working, rejoicing, or suffering alone, but at their side is Jesus, with Mary, His Mother and ours, to sustain them, to dry the sweat of their brow, giving value to their toil. Teach them to turn work into a very high instrument of sanctification as you did. Amen."
