STEWARDSHIP WEEKEND  
APRIL 27-28, 2024

Very soon, Deacon Jonah Brox will be completing his time here at our Parish. We have been very grateful that Deacon Jonah was assigned to our Parish for his Diaconate Internship. His presence and his ministry have been a special blessing to us, and we thank him very much. We are especially grateful for his assistance at our weekend liturgies and for his preaching the Word of God.

As many of our parishioners are aware, part of Deacon Brox's formation included evaluations of his homilies. Each time that Deacon Brox preached at our weekend Masses, two parishioners independently completed an evaluation form, together with the celebrant of the Mass. His evaluations were exceptional. Our parishioners have provided very honest feedback to Deacon Brox, complimenting him on his preparation, his delivery, his content, and his personal style of preaching. In addition to the formal evaluations, many parishioners have commented to me about Deacon Brox's ability to maintain eye contact during his homily. His ability to do so provided the congregation with a true sense of his words coming from his heart. In my own personal evaluation, I mentioned in my letter to Bishop Keith Chylinski, the Rector of St. Charles Seminary, that Deacon Jonah's homilies are very much scripturally-based, and at the same time, he brought his own personal story/perspective wherein the congregation can ascertain as to how the readings apply to their personal lives. Very often, he left the congregation with a challenge for the coming week.

And so, I am very grateful to our parishioners who participated in the evaluations, for they have greatly assisted the seminary in their responsibility of preparing Deacon Jonah for the priesthood. From our Parish's perspective, the good news is that Deacon Brox has been with us for the past several months; the better news is that the people of the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska will be blessed through the soon-to-be Father Brox's gift of preaching the Word of God and his overall ministry as a priest for their diocese.

Next weekend, April 20th-21st, will be Deacon Brox's final weekend here at St. Frances Cabrini, and we will have the opportunity to bid him goodbye when we have hospitality on the Gathering Circle following the 11:00 AM Mass.

With much gratitude for Deacon Jonah and the blessing that he has been for us here at St. Frances Cabrini, as a Parish Community, we ask God's continued blessing upon him, and as pastor, I invite our parishioners to keep Deacon Brox in your prayers as he prepares for ordination to the priesthood on Saturday, May 25th, and for his Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, May 26th.

When available, we will be providing our parishioners with a link for the live streaming of the Ordination Mass.

Recently, I sent a letter to all our registered parishioners regarding Stewardship Weekend. Hopefully, it will be arriving soon. In my letter, I provided an interim Financial Report as of January 31, 2024 and also a Comparative Statement of Operations for the seven-month period ended January 31, 2023 and 2024. Next weekend, we will be providing a Stewardship Booklet which presents an overview of our Parish Ministries, Organizations and Programs.

As I mentioned in my letter, on the weekend of April 27-28, we will be having Stewardship Weekend. In a concerted effort to promote the spirit of Stewardship as a way of



life, and as a true disciple's response to God's goodness to us, I am asking our parishioners to prayerfully consider sharing their time, talent, and treasure with others. Remembering the words of Pope Francis, our Holy Father said that "a Church without charity does not exist," and therefore, it is very important that all our parishioners be fully engaged in the life of the Parish, sharing their time, talent, and treasure for the good of others. As our parishioners would remember, "increased commitment and involvement in parish life," is one of our top three priorities of our Parish Pastoral Plan. For those already involved in a Parish ministry, I thank you and I encourage you to continue your commitment. If you are not already involved, I invite you to become more fully engaged in the life of the Parish by expressing your interest in a ministry, organization, or program on Stewardship Weekend. Also, I encourage our parishioners to continue in their commitment to tithing, and to assist the Parish in the special collection on Stewardship Weekend, utilizing the Annual Treasure Sunday Appeal envelope, which has been provided for this purpose. If possible, we are respectfully suggesting a \$150.00 offering per family. As we have done in previous years, non-working persons are asked to give only according to their means. Again, as we did in previous years, Interest Cards are being utilized for our parishioners to express their interest in our ministries, organizations, and programs. On the weekend of April 27-28, at post-Communion time during our Masses, a completed Interest Card and the Stewardship Envelope can be placed in the second collection or, if you prefer, at your convenience, they can be dropped off at the rectory, or placed in another envelope and mailed to the rectory.

On behalf of the entire Parish Community, I thank you for your prayerful support of our Parish, and our specific endeavors, and I thank you for your continued financial commitment to our Parish Community.
