## Parish Pastoral Personnel Changes Monsignor McCormac

As our Pastoral Team continues to implement our Parish Pastoral Plan, we readily recognize that we need to better utilize the various social media platforms which are available to our Parish Community. Surveys show that 72% of all Americans use some kind of social media. The latest statistics show that 80% of nonprofit organizations use a website, 71% of nonprofit organizations use social media and 67% of nonprofit organizations use email. With these statistics, the takeaway is that if our Parish wants to communicate effectively, social media is no longer a "nice to have" but an essential line of communication. To better communicate with our parishioners, recently, we upgraded our Parish database application. This new application, known as Realm, has greater capabilities for communication. And so, with a vision for increasing our ability to better communicate the gospel mandate to proclaim Jesus, I have asked Jean Madden to take on a new responsibility to oversee the various aspects of social media. For many years, in addition to her other responsibilities as Director of Religious Education and Director of Music, Jean has been overseeing and providing updates and posting information on our Parish website and our Parish Facebook page. And so, in order to provide Jean with more time to be fully dedicated to exploring the potential of using social media more widely and more effectively, I have created the position of Director of Social Media and have appointed Jean to this position. In light of this change for Jean, concurrently, we are looking for a new Director of Religious Education. We have posted the position on our Archdiocesan website, and we are asking our local pastors to advertise this position as well.

Another personnel change in our Pastoral Staff involves Theresa Leonetti O'Connor, our Director of Parish Services. As our parishioners know, Theresa has been here at our Parish since September 2022. Although Theresa has appreciated being here and ministering within our

Parish Community, sadly, she has concluded that the hours needed to fulfill the many responsibilities of her position have been very stressful for her. Recently, Theresa indicated to me that she really needs a position which requires only daytime hours and ideally, even a part-time position with less hours than she is currently carrying. Theresa was offered the part-time position of Director of Religious Education but since this position requires evening hours as well as weekend hours, she has respectfully declined our offer. And so, Theresa will be here until the end of May. We are grateful for Theresa and her ministry among us. Please keep Theresa in your prayers as she prayerfully seeks new employment. Thank you.

Finally, although not related to Theresa leaving our Pastoral Staff, I am pleased to announce that Audrey Wilson is returning to our Pastoral Staff on a part-time basis. As our parishioners would remember, Audrey stepped away from her ministries in May 2022 in order to provide full-time care for her dear mother, Ann. As Audrey continues to mourn her mom, greatly missing her presence, she has reunited herself more fully to the Parish Community, being present for Mass and once again being present at our Wednesday morning Bible Study gatherings and joining the women with our Walking with Purpose program. Just recently, Audrey indicated that she is ready to resume some of her previous ministries. Audrey will also be involved with our Small Faith Sharing Groups which are starting this month, and she will also be involved in preparing our next Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist. With much gratitude, we welcome Audrey back to our Pastoral Staff.

With gratitude for Theresa and her presence among us, for Jean and her willingness to assume her new responsibilities and for the return of Audrey, I give praise and thanks to God for His goodness to our Parish Community.

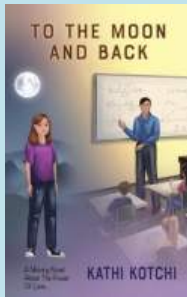

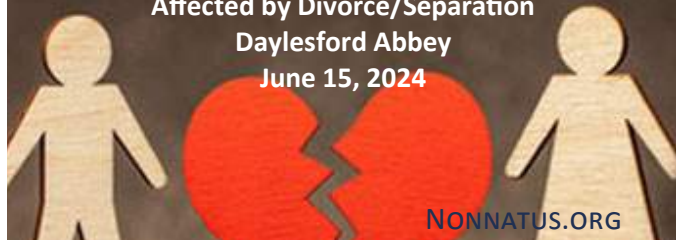

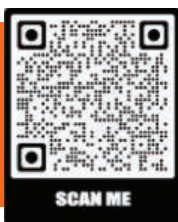
