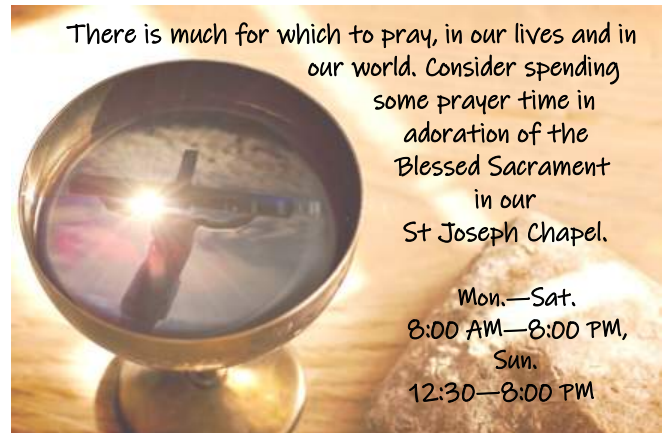

Stewardship Weekend Results

Monsignor McCormac

We are pleased to report on the response to Stewardship Weekend, which was held on April 27–28. There were 46 parishioners who expressed an interest in learning more about one or more of our Parish Ministries, Programs, and Organizations. We are also pleased to note that we currently have over 300 parishioners actively involved in parish life. With these parishioners already involved, and now with another additional 46 parishioners expressing interest, our Parish Community continues to be very vibrant with our parishioners sharing their time and talent for the good of others. We also continue to enjoy a wonderful reputation of being a warm and welcoming community. Just recently, a woman who lives quite a distance from our church told me that her first attraction to our Parish Community was a greeter who met her at the door of the church and then how friendly other parishioners were toward her after entering the church building. As Pastor, I was delighted to hear this!

In addition to our parishioners being involved in parish life, our parishioners are also participating more actively during our Eucharistic celebrations through their verbal responses, their singing, and their reverent silence. As a priest, I am so grateful and so blessed to be part of such a wonderful experience of praising and thanking God for His goodness to our Parish.

As part of the follow up process, letters were sent to all those who expressed an interest. Letters were also sent to the leaders of our organizations, notifying them of the names and phone numbers of those who expressed an interest in their ministry, program, or organization. I suggested that calls be

made to provide a proper explanation of the goals and activities of their ministry, program, or organization. If for some reason, someone signed up, but did not receive a letter, we ask that the rectory office be contacted. Follow up by the leaders of our Parish ministries and organizations should be taking place between now and June 21st.

Regarding the Stewardship Weekend collection, thus far, we have received \$23,654 from our parishioners. For this, I am very grateful. It is indeed most gratifying to see this level of contribution given the high rate of inflation being experienced, and the financial demands facing our parishioners. Last year's Stewardship Weekend collection was \$26,418. I am very grateful for the financial sacrifices being made by our parishioners in supporting our Parish Community.

On behalf of all those whom we serve, I thank our parishioners for their personal commitment of time, talent, and treasure!

I am pleased to say that St. Charles Seminary has informed me that we were once again chosen to have a transitional deacon from the Diocese of Lincoln. On the weekend of September 7–8, we will be pleased to welcome Deacon Issac Wahlmeier when he begins his Diaconate Internship here at St. Frances Cabrini Parish Community. In his letter to me, Bishop Keith Chylinski, the Rector of St. Charles Seminary, said that an essential component of a seminarian's priestly training is pastoral formation and that he is very grateful to our Parish Community for the experiences and formation that will support and assist Deacon Wahlmeier. Our new deacon will be the fifth deacon to be assigned here, and he is our fourth deacon from the Diocese of Lincoln. On Friday, May 24th, seminarian Issac Wahlmeier was ordained to the diaconate for the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska. As Deacon Wahlmeier enters his summer assignment in Lincoln and anticipates coming to our Parish Community in September, let us remember him in our prayers.

Let us also remember Father Jonah Brox, who was ordained on May 25th. Father Brox will soon begin his priestly ministry and let us also pray for our other former deacons, Father Caleb Hile, Father Tyler Sparrow, and Father Dominic Winter.

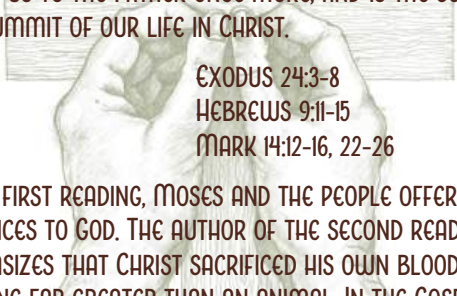

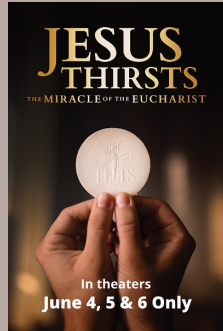

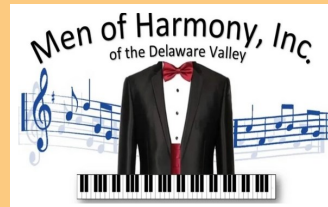
