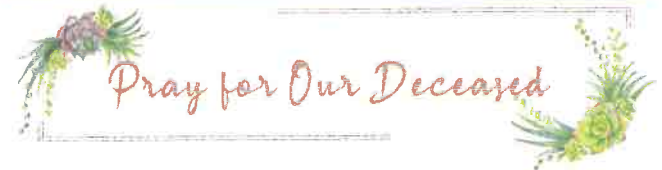

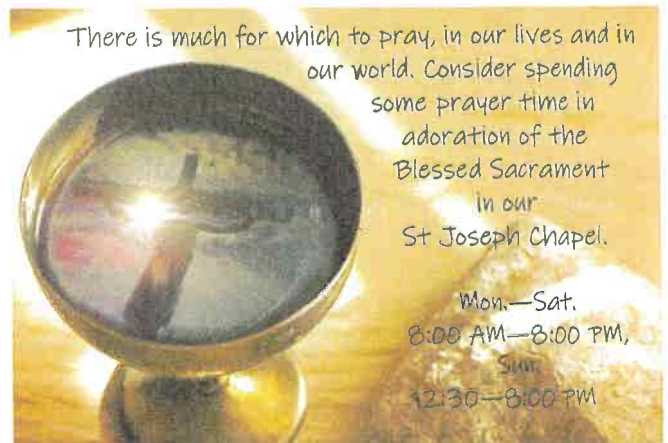

## Monthly Gathering of Small Faith Sharing Groups

I thank all of you for your prayerful support of my ongoing bereavement at the loss of my dear Mom. I am greatly comforted to know she is at peace with the Lord and my dear Dad.

I also would like to express my deep gratitude for your warm and supportive welcome of my return to the Parish Staff. It is indeed a great blessing to join Monsignor McCormac and the Staff in serving the Lord, the Church, and all of you.

In this week's message, I would like to update you on our new Parish Initiative involving Small Faith Sharing Groups. Flowing from our Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist, we are happy to report that 13 Small Faith Sharing Groups were formed. These groups have already met at various times and days over the course of the past month of May. These Small Faith Sharing Groups met for one hour to share their reflections and thoughts on the first chapter of Matthew Kelly's book "Beautiful Eucharist."

The sessions began with warm welcomes, prayer involving Lectio Divina, and then faith sharing on the content of Chapter One. It was a truly moving and uplifting hour hearing folks beautifully and readily share their belief in the sacramental presence of the Lord Jesus in the Eucharist and how this reception of the Lord at Mass effects their daily lives.

In every group, those participating further shared their experiences of the Mass and how their prayer at Mass has been enhanced and deepened especially by their participation in the Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist. The shared reflection of the reading provided a means to give voice to this. There were many

expressions of experiencing the Mass and praying at Mass with new eyes and a new heart. Everyone left these sessions eager to meet the following month.

The Holy Spirit was truly present at these gatherings assisting us to accept the invitation from our good and gracious God by stopping our daily routines and pausing to reflect on what matters most in life, namely, our faith and love of the Lord, God's tremendous and personal love for each of us, as particularly made present and given to us in the Eucharist, and how we bring and manifest that love in our daily lives.

Saint Pope John Paul II wrote in the 80s and 90s that participation in faith sharing groups allow us to tell our own story and learn from it. We, as followers of Jesus, need to tell our stories to each other. Hearing these stories was truly an amazing blessing and a great witness to our shared faith with one another.

To those who have joined these groups we say thank you. We extend a special thank you to those who have so generously stepped forward to facilitate these sessions. You are indeed a great blessing to our community. Your love of the Lord, the Mass, and one another is so uplifting and edifying.
