



These Small Faith Sharing Groups met for one hour to share their reflections and thoughts on the first chapter of Matthew Kelly's book "Beautiful Eucharist."

The sessions began with warm welcomes, prayer involving Lectio Divina, and then faith sharing on the content of Chapter One. It was a truly moving and uplifting hour hearing folks beautifully and readily share their belief in the sacramental presence of the Lord Jesus in the Eucharist and how this reception of the Lord at Mass effects their daily lives.


