### Archdiocesan Strategic Planning Process Part Three

**Monsignor McCormac** 

As the Archdiocese moves forward with the Fourth way, that is, with their unique approach to planning for the future, and recognizing that the approach is only now being formulated with the input of both priests and laity, there are certain key elements. The Archdiocese wants to avoid certain elements and they want to ensure certain elements, namely:

Avoid:

- Mass consolidation of parishes;
- Creating more "ecclesial deserts" especially in poor areas of the Archdiocese;
- Establishing permanent multi-parish pastoring situations;
- Poor stewardship of financial resources.

Ensure:


- A culture of missionary discipleship;
- A robust presence in each deanery, especially in current ecclesial deserts;
- Financial capital and human talent that will allow communities to thrive; involvement of Catholics currently in their 30s, 40s, and 50s;
- Care and honor of the priests' vocation
- Support from the Archdiocese.

With regard to the term "ecclesial desert," this is referring to areas of the Archdiocese where is there is a lack of presence of the Catholic Church due to the closing of parishes over the years, especially in North Philadelphia, the City of Chester and other parts of the

Archdiocese. With regard to the term "deanery," this is referring to the 12 districts within the Archdiocese which have been designated by the Archdiocese for governance. There are twelve priests chosen by fellow priests to oversee their particular deanery on behalf of the Archbishop.

Regarding the Archdiocesan vision for the future and specifically their vision of Missionary Hubs, the purpose of the Missionary Hubs is to ensure through talent, resources, support, and accountability, there are communities that are intentionally turned to evangelization. The second purpose is ensure as other parishes change over time, there will be communities that are present and oriented to welcome individuals who might have to go somewhere they feel comfortable and welcomed because of the evangelization work that has happened over time. In time, the Archdiocese will be creating 50 Missionary Hubs, with 10 Hubs in each of the five counties in the Archdiocese.

In the fall, as more information becomes available, I will certainly be updating our Parish leadership, and also our parishioners. In the meantime, please remember our Archdiocesan leadership and our Parish leaders in your prayer as the Archdiocesan Strategic Planning Process continues.




