

As our parishioners would know, we have been working with the Catholic Leadership Institute as part of their Next Generation Catholic Parish Initiative. Through this endeavor, we have assessed our Parish's communications and effectiveness in light of our culture. We created a Parish Pastoral Plan with priorities and goals. And we are now implementing that Plan through our Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist, the expansion of Martha's Cupboard, and the formation of Small Faith Sharing Groups. Another outcome of our involvement with the Catholic Leadership Institute is the creation of the Director of Social Media position here at Saint Frances Cabrini.

In the secular world, the role of a Social Media Director is to promote the mission of a company or organization using the latest social media and communication tools available. According to Indeed.com, "the primary duty of a Social Media Director is brand development through the use of social media." Brand development is knowing your organization's core message and unique traits and sharing that information with others. What do we stand for? What is our purpose or reason for being? What makes us unique as a Catholic Parish? Brand development is also knowing your audience. Who are our parishioners? What are their daily lives really like? What are the best ways to communicate with them? How can we make our vision relevant to them? Who might be drawn to our Parish Community? How do we find them, reach out to them, share our vision with them?

As the Director of Social Media for Saint Frances Cabrini Parish, I will be discerning ways to effectively use technology to share our Parish Mission and our Parish identity. Working with the Parish Pastoral Staff and Parish Leaders, I will be creating content, scheduling posts, and monitoring metrics. But most importantly, I will be engaging with parishioners to foster spiritual growth and provide intentional missionary disciples from within our Parish for the evangelization of the teachings of Jesus Christ to the wider communities of Fairless Hills, Fallsington, and Levittown.

Pope Francis said, "The revolution taking place in communications media and in information technologies represents a great and thrilling challenge; may we respond to that challenge with fresh energy and imagination as we seek to share with others the beauty of God." I am looking forward to working with our Pastoral Staff and Parish Leaders to address the challenges of social media and to use all of the resources available to advance the goals of our Parish Pastoral Plan, drawing others to the awesomeness of our God as we bring Christ to the world around us.

In the first reading, Amos is called a prophet by a priest of Bethel. He responds that God took him from following the flock as a shepherd and sent him to prophesy. In the epistle, Paul writes that we are chosen and that God has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing. In the Gospel, Jesus sends the Twelve out two by two and instructs them to take nothing for their journey


