## REFLECTION ON THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

Hank Wajda

Hello to our St. Frances Cabrini Parish family. My name is Hank Wajda, and I am the principal organist here at the parish. I have been asked to share my thoughts about the National Eucharistic Congress, which was held from July 17 – 21 at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis. I had the privilege of attending this Eucharistic Congress with my friend and fellow parishioner, Dave Parker.

I was originally drawn to the National Eucharistic Congress by the Eucharistic pilgrimages that began on Pentecost Sunday, taking place around the country. There were four of these pilgrimages, called "From the Four Corners" that travelled with the Blessed Sacrament from the north, south, east and west that headed to Indianapolis for the start of the National Eucharistic Congress. The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Route began in New Haven, Connecticut, and passed through the Archdiocese of Philadelphia between May 30 and June 3. Locally, we experienced the Eucharistic Adoration at Holy Trinity Parish in Morrisville, and at St. John The Evangelist in Lower Makefield. The whole idea was to bring Jesus to all people in a very public way. As the Monstrance moved along the streets, pilgrims could be seen falling to their knees in prayer and reverence. After stops at our local parishes, the procession continued west into Philadelphia, and ultimately arriving with the other three Eucharistic Processions from the North, South, and West. The spontaneous acts of reverence to our Eucharistic Lord were powerful signs that our Church is Alive, and Jesus is still with His Bride, the Church.

The National Eucharistic Congress began on Wednesday, July 17. I was not able to leave for the congress until Saturday, July 20 due to conflicts in my schedule, but I was watching the excellent coverage provided by the Catholic broadcasting network EWTN. The speakers were outstanding, and the music was moving and inspirational. What really touched my heart was watching 55,000 pilgrims as they praised and worshipped our mighty God in adoration. In a stadium that is normally loud and filled with faithful Colts fans, here were 55,000 people praising and adoring our mighty God. All of the events of the National Eucharistic Congress are archived on the internet for each of you if you would like to relive and experience

the events of the Congress. I will provide a link to all of the events that took place in Indianapolis.

One of my favorite talks was by Mother Olga of the Sacred Heart. She shared her stories of Eucharistic miracles that she has observed. In one particularly touching story, Mother Olga tells the story about baby Emma, born at twenty-two weeks, and weighing just one pound. Mother Olga asked permission to place a PYX in baby Emma's incubator each Sunday when she would visit. Little Emma remained in the NICU for 191 days. In one very touching photograph, we see little Emma reach her tiny fingers to touch Jesus. Mother Olga asked Jesus, "Please hold her hand because she is reaching out to You." Little Emma grew stronger and in May, she celebrated her first birthday, and weighed eighteen pounds. Mother Olga says this is a real miracle, and that Our Lord revealed His REAL PRESENCE IN THE HOLY EUCHARIST. If you get the chance to listen to Mother Olga's full talk, you'll hear additional examples of Eucharistic miracles. (Just search for Mother Olga in YouTube)

Finally, there was the closing Mass. Once again, I felt a connection to this Mass. My friend, Rich Grillone, grew up here in Bucks County, and is the music Director at St. Denis parish in Havertown. He is a talented composer who wrote the arrangements of all of the music that was played by the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra at the closing Mass. He also conducted the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra for the closing Mass. If you get a chance to watch a part of the Mass, you'll be able to experience the beauty of the closing Mass.

In conclusion, I hope that you feel uplifted, and that you will experience some of the events and talks of the National Eucharistic Congress. I saw a faith on display at the Congress that is beautiful, alive, and waiting to be shared, much like I see every Sunday among the faithful here at St. Frances Cabrini. At the end of Mass, we were charged with finding just one person who is lost, and guiding that person back to the faith. Whether a neighbor, family member or a friend, we become missionary disciples working to build God's kingdom here on earth. The National Eucharistic Congress made me proud to be a Catholic, and my prayer is that you can say the same, too. As Mother Olga concludes her message, "We have Him, and no one can take Him away from us!"

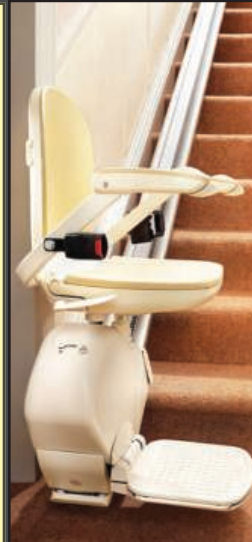
