

"COME AND SEE" THROUGH THE AMAZING FAITH ENRICHMENT SERIES ON THE EUCHARIST

Audrey Wilson, our parishioner and also our Director of Parish Services offers an invitation to you:

It is with great joy, anticipation and excitement that I offer you this invitation to participate in our upcoming Adult Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist. This Series will help us to enter more deeply into the Mass and to receive all the grace and love God desires to give us. It will also help us to offer praise and thanks to God with our whole being, and to join that praise in one full voice as a community of faith and love.

We encourage everyone who participated in the Faith Enrichment Series last year to please join us again. We will continue our Series where we left off in February, which was at the conclusion of the Eucharistic Prayer. To those who were not able to participate last year, we welcome you to please come and join us as we present and reflect on the Communion Rite of the Mass.

Last year's Faith Enrichment Series was truly an amazing and grace-filled experience. We grew in our understanding of the Mass, which resulted in a fuller, richer participation in our celebration of Mass as a Parish Community.

We experienced a greater sense of community and deepened our bonds with one another as we gathered in those sessions. In a non-threatening and comforting way, we came to know one another and felt at home with each other. No longer did we know someone as "Oh, you are the one who sits on the Blessed Mother Side of the church" or "I see you at the 7AM Mass."

In support of our invitation to you, we invited three parishioners who participated in the previous Faith Enrichment Series to share what they experienced.

Our parishioner, PJ Day, shared the following reflection:

I participated in each of the Faith Enrichment Series sessions last year and I am grateful for what they have done for me, for it is amazing. I consider myself blessed to be part of the Saint Frances Cabrini family. I say family because it feels like family to me, and I was blessed to share the experience of the Faith Enrichment Series with my Parish family. I have learned things in the Series that I could never have imagined.

Before the Series, sometimes I would start to drift off at Mass. I think maybe because I thought I knew what was happening, or what was going to happen next, or maybe for a lack of a better word, I was bored. But through the Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist, I learned that every word and action during Mass has meaning, and I was touched by all that I learned. I now watch for the priest to hold his hands over the bread and wine because I know he is saying the words that will call down the Holy Spirit and through the power of the Holy Spirit and the words of consecration, the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. Or when I pray the Holy, Holy, Holy, and say blessed is He Who comes in the name of the Lord, it is Jesus who is coming to me! Wow!

I would just go through the motions at Mass, not really knowing what I was saying. Now, when I participate at Mass, I am locked into every word. It is truly amazing. Even the word "enrichment" has more meaning to me now. Enrichment means to improve or enhance, and that is exactly what this Series is all about, improving and enhancing our celebration of Mass. So please, I invite you to come to the Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist in October. I want to thank Monsignor McCormac and all those involved for giving us this wonderful gift."

Our parishioner, Megan McCormick, shared the following reflection:

"Last year, parents of children preparing to receive a Sacrament were asked to participate in the Faith Enrichment Series. I attended these sessions for the benefit of myself and also my daughter, Emma, who is in PREP. After attending these four Faith Enrichment Series sessions, I learned so much about how things work in church and why we do certain things. I had thoughtful discussions with the members of my group. I highly encourage people to join the Faith Enrichment Series. Once we attended Mass, I was able to explain what was going on in the Mass more thoughtfully to my daughter and it was really a great experience. I hope you will take the time to engage in these Faith Enrichment Series sessions."

Our parishioner, Carole Seymour, shared the following reflection:

"I'd like to invite you to come to the Faith Enrichment Series, a place where you'll find some answers to the questions of why we, as Catholics, believe what we claim to believe and how the Mass is central to helping our faith to grow. What I found by attending is that none of us has all the answers, but this was a place to learn more by being part of the conversation or by listening and learning from the conversation of others like you who want to know more or who know the answers to the questions you're asking. Come and see!"

Audrey Wilson continues her invitation and reflection:

As we gathered each time for the Series, we looked forward to seeing one another and anticipating what greater or newer understanding of a prayer or action of the Mass we were going to receive.

We indeed received the Lord's grace and felt in a real way the presence of the Holy Spirit throughout the Series. The grace so generously given by our Good and Gracious God caused us to desire Christ more and more in the Eucharist. Many of us at the end of a session would say to one another. "I wish we could run over to church right now for Mass."

Folks, I cannot reiterate enough what a great experience this will be for all of us. It is the most important way we can spend our time and energy besides coming to Mass in person. Our hearts were created for God, and we are most satisfied and at peace when we are fully participating at Mass. Indeed, in no greater way can we be joined with heaven and earth and all those we love who are with the Lord celebrating in the heavenly banquet.

Our Faith Enrichment Series will include four sessions. Two sessions will be offered in October at three different times, Wednesday evenings, Saturday mornings, and Sunday evenings. Two more sessions will be offered in February at the same time. You decide what time is most convenient for you. 


