There are people down the street from you (or maybe even next door or in your own home) who are missing out on Catholic community—an essential part of our spiritual lives. They may not even realize their soul is aching to be nourished by the Bread of Life. Try inviting them to attend Mass with you that they may return to a community that desires to welcome them.

## Increased Offertory Appeal

Monsignor McCormac

Most, if not all, pastors find it is very difficult to speak about money; however, as Pastor, I have the responsibility to do so. I am very grateful to our parishioners for their continued financial support and I recognize the need to be a good steward of the funds entrusted to the Parish. To that end, in August I provided our parishioners with a Financial Report for the year ended June 30, 2024. I also provided an overview of our current financial situation, noting that, like everyone else, our Parish has been feeling the effects of severe inflation and our Sunday collections continue to fall short in meeting our annual expenses. For the past year, our Sunday collections covered only 61% of our operating expenses. This percentage of Sunday collections versus operating expenses has been decreasing for many years. In 2017-2018, it was 74%. To support our ministries, to continue providing for the spiritual needs of our community, and to maintain our facilities, we must take a proactive step forward.

Recognizing the need to do something to reverse this downward trend, we are undertaking an initiative to increase our Sunday collections. After consultation with our Parish Finance Council and our Parish Pastoral Council and working closely with the Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia, we are initiating an Increased Offertory Appeal. I recognize that for many people, if not most people, the subject of money is an overly sensitive issue, but it is a very necessary topic for our Parish Community. Our last Increased Offertory Appeal was conducted in October 2015, one year after the merging of St. Frances Cabrini and St. Joseph the Worker Parishes. Although professional consultants recommend that an Increased Offertory Appeal should be conducted every three to five years, as pastor, I have been reluctant to undertake an appeal until now. Ideally, October 2020 would have been the time to conduct the Program, but due to COVID, and because of the state of our economy and feeling the financial hardship being faced by our parishioners, I postponed the

Increased Offertory Appeal for the past four years. But now, I believe that it is necessary to do so.

During the month of October, our parishioners will be receiving a letter asking that they prayerfully consider increasing their weekly/monthly Sunday contributions to the Parish. It is the experience of many people that they routinely give a set amount for their Sunday contribution, but rarely do they change the amount unless they are requested to do so.

Here at St. Frances Cabrini Parish, we desire to create a “culture of giving” within our Parish Community. Recognizing that we are so very gifted by our loving and generous God, we are called to cheerfully share our gifts with our Parish family. Specifically, God calls us to share our gifts of time, talent and treasure. Although there are so many examples of our parishioners sharing their time, talent, and treasure, the most recent example is our parishioners’ support of our very expanded Martha’s Cupboard. Our Parish Community is providing more food than ever and, as pastor, I am so very proud of our Parish’s response to our brothers and sisters who are experiencing food insecurity. Also, as our parishioners know, we are once again conducting our Faith Enrichment Series and as we do so, we are relying on many parishioners giving their time to help facilitate the Series.

As the Increased Offertory Appeal soon begins, I thank everyone for taking the time to prayerfully reflect on their current level of financial support for the Parish, and if possible, to consider increasing their weekly contribution.

Thank you again for all you do for the Parish and please pray for a very successful Increased Offertory Appeal.


