Electronic Giving

Karen David

I'm Karen David and my husband, Bob, and I have been parishioners at St. Frances Cabrini for the past 35 years. I also have the privilege of being the Parish Business Manager for the past 17 years.

As Parish Business Manager, my responsibilities include the Parish finances and the maintenance and upkeep of our campus facilities. My most important responsibility, however, is to be a good steward of the funds entrusted to us by you, our parishioners. It is a responsibility I take very seriously, and I appreciate this opportunity to personally thank all of you for your generosity toward the Parish.

Like many of you, on a personal level, I spend a lot of time price shopping to be sure that I'm getting the best price on purchases and services. As Business Manager, I manage our Parish finances with the same diligence because prices today are escalating faster than you and I can keep up. Over time the amount needed to bridge the gap between the income from Sunday collections and our expenses has been growing, especially with the stubborn high rate of inflation. This is the problem we now face, and it is the main reason for conducting an increased offertory appeal at this time. So, I hope that those of you who are able to do so will prayerfully consider the request to increase your contribution.

As Monsignor McCormac mentioned during his talk last weekend, he uses electronic giving for his contributions to the Parish. The reason we encourage electronic giving is that it provides consistency in the contributions we receive, and consistency is important when trying to manage income and expenses.

Electronic giving is convenient for our parishioners because once you set up the giving amount and frequency of your choice, you never have to be concerned about it again. There is no need to catch up when you're out of town for the weekend or on vacation, or worrying about writing a check or making sure you have cash before you come to Mass.

Our Parish provides several options for electronic giving, and you decide which one is best for you.

The first option is Online Bank Pay through your own banking institution. Most banks provides a free and convenient bill paying service for its customers where you can pay your car

insurance, your credit card, your doctor...anything you would normally pay by check. With Online Bill Pay, instead of you writing a check, the bank will write the check and mail it for you. Many of you probably already use this service.

To use Online Bill Pay for your Parish contributions, simply add the Parish as a payee by entering the Parish name and address. It only takes minutes to log in and set up a new payee and you only have to enter the information once. You decide how much and how often, and the bank will automatically send us a check on a weekly or monthly basis. Set it up once and you do not have to write a check again. And the best part of this option is that the service is free to you and there are no fees charged to the Parish.

The next two options utilize an application called Parish Giving. We use Parish Giving because it is simple to set up and your account is protected by multiple layers of security. Through Parish Giving, you can authorize an electronic fund transfer between your bank account and the Parish bank account. You simply set up a Parish Giving account, provide them with your bank account information and schedule a recurring transfer on a weekly or monthly basis.

Parish Giving also provides the option to use a credit card rather than a bank account. Some people like this option because they receive points for the amounts they charge to their credit card. The same as with a bank transfer, you set up a Parish Giving account, give them your credit card information and Parish Giving will regularly initiate a credit card payment for your donation at the frequency and date that you choose.

Parish Giving services are free to our parishioners, but they do charge fees to the Parish.

All three options are safe and secure and provide access to your account where you can keep track of your contributions. You decide how much, how often and when your contribution is provided. And you only need to set it up once.

If anyone has questions about any of these electronic giving options, or would like some assistance in setting them up, please give me a call at the rectory. I've had many parishioners come to my office and we've set up their accounts together. I'm happy to assist in any way I can.

Thank you once again for your generosity and support. May the Lord continue to bless you and your family and our Parish community.

"Whatever causes you to sin, get rid of it."




