The St. Charles Borromeo Seminary 2024-2025 Annual Appeal has begun. Recently, our parishioners should have received a direct mailing from the Seminary. Included in the Seminary's mailing would have been a very well-done booklet containing testimonials from Archbishop Nelson Perez and Bishop Keith Chylinski, rector of St. Charles Seminary. The booklet also reflects other testimonials and highlights the education and formation taking place at the Seminary. The theme for this year is "For Today. For Tomorrow. For all of us." The goal for 2024-2025 is \$3.5 million. 
