### **Christmas Caroling for the Homebound**

Since December 2017, parishioners and friends of Saint Frances Cabrini Church have gathered on the Thursday after Christmas to spread the joy and cheer of Christmas through the gift of song. Christmas Caroling for the Homebound is a heartfelt tradition where groups of people visit the homes of those who find it challenging or impossible to leave their home during the holiday season. These visits are often made to elderly individuals, people with disabilities, people preparing for major surgery, people doing rehabilitation post-surgery, or those facing a chronic illness. The short visit by the carolers provides them with a sense of connection and warmth during the holidays. Caroling for the homebound is more than just singing Christmas songs—it's an opportunity to remind these individuals that they are remembered, valued, and loved by their Parish community.

Family members and caretakers of homebound individuals often find great joy in a visit by Christmas carolers because it offers a moment of festive cheer, provides a welcome break from the daily routine of caregiving, and fills their hearts with the holiday spirit. For those caring for loved ones, the carolers' songs can evoke cherished memories, enhance their emotional well-being, and create a shared experience that strengthens the sense of community. The simple act of welcoming carolers to sing on their doorstep can provide a sense of renewal and joy, making the holiday season feel more special and inclusive for everyone involved.

Participating as a caroler for Christmas Caroling for the Homebound is a powerful way to share the true meaning of Christmas, which goes beyond gift-giving, decorations, and parties. Caroling is also a chance to dress up in festive attire, embrace the holiday cheer, and spread happiness, making it a joyful and lighthearted tradition that fosters a sense of community and goodwill.

On Thursday, December 26th, our carolers will gather in the Parish Center at 6:00 PM. Song sheets and maps of the caroling route will be distributed. Those who offer to drive will be paired with carolers who prefer not to drive. The caravan will line up on Gobel Court and will head out to our first home at 6:30 PM. As we move from home to home, we call the next home on the list to let them know we are on our way. Our goal is to visit every home on the list by 8:30 PM. The carolers end the evening with light refreshments in the Parish Center., taking a few minutes to savor the profound joy of the evening over a cup of hot chocolate, coffee or tea. 
