## AN INVITATION TO A CONVERSATION REGARDING THE FUTURE OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH OF PHILADELPHIA

What does it mean to be "Catholic?" There are many paragraphs in the Catechism of the Catholic Church that help clarify the core beliefs and identity of Catholics. In fact, you could say that defining what it means to be Catholic is the main goal of that publication. When you have a few minutes, you might want to read paragraphs 747, 818, 849, 874, and 1427. These paragraphs basically say that being Catholic means belonging to a community that is centered around faith in Jesus Christ, living according to His teachings, and participating in the Sacramental life of the Church. It involves being part of the universal Church, called to holiness, and contributing to the mission of spreading the Gospel.

If we conducted a "random person on the street interview," like what used to be a popular feature of late-night television shows, and asked people "What does it mean to them to be Catholic?" we would probably hear a wide range of responses. Some of those answers might line up perfectly with the words from the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Other answers might be slightly different and still others could be drastically different. Our definition of "being Catholic" is influenced by the religious education, life experiences, and the community of faith through which our spiritual lives were formed. The depth of our faith and the authenticity of our identity as a Catholic can be greatly impacted by family dynamics, society, our participation, or lack of participation, in the Sacramental life of the Church, and the extent to which we belong to and engage with a parish community, where we find support, accountability, and a shared sense of mission.

Currently, in parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, only 17% of baptized Catholics participate in the Sacramental life of the Church and even fewer are actively engaged in their parish community. As Archbishop Nelson Perez and the Archdiocesan Strategic Planning Team formulate the plan for growing the Church of Philadelphia over the next twenty years, they seek to create an environment where that 17% can continue to thrive and the 83% who have drifted away or have been driven away from the practice of their faith are welcomed home.

These are challenging times for the Universal Church, for the Church of Philadelphia, and for our own Saint Frances Cabrini Parish. The number of couples getting married in the Church, the number of parents requesting Baptism for their children, the number of people in the pews for any given weekend Mass, the number of people contributing to the financial support of the parish, the number of families making sacrifices to provide a Catholic School education for their children, as well as the number of families sending their children to

the Parish Religious Education Program, in all of these areas, the numbers are dropping. And yet, as it says in the Book of Lamentations, "the favors of the Lord are not exhausted, they are renewed each morning." Great is the mercy and compassion of our God. We have reason to hope.

Here at Saint Frances Cabrini, the 17% who gather for Mass each weekend participate with reverence and enthusiasm. Well over 200 people have participated in our Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist. Martha's Cupboard continues to grow in the number of active volunteers and the number of families we can serve in the communities of Fairless Hills, Fallsington, and Levittown. So many men and women are spiritually uplifted through their participation in Small Faith Sharing Groups, the Men's Prayer Group, Walking with Purpose, and Bible Study. Parishioners and others from the surrounding area who are mourning the loss of a loved one are comforted through our Bereavement Ministry. The beauty of our Liturgical celebrations is greatly enhanced by the large number of parishioners involved in Lay Liturgical Ministries. How do we address the challenges we face while continuing to grow in the areas that are flourishing and how does all of this fit into the plans for the future of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia?

On Tuesday, February 11th, Deacon James O'Neill, a representative from the Archdiocesan Strategic Planning Team will be here at Saint Frances Cabrini to share with us a vision for the future of the Church of Philadelphia and to enter into a conversation with us regarding those plans. All are invited to attend this meeting, from the daily Mass attendees who are actively involved in several parish organizations and ministries, to those who attend weekend Mass and try to participate as much as they can, to our family and friends who have not been to Mass recently and who do not participate in parish activities, all are welcome. The future of the Church of Philadelphia should be a vitally important topic for all of us. Come to Monsignor Woods Hall on Tuesday, February 11, from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM and join in the conversation about what it will mean to be a Catholic in the Church of Philadelphia in the next twenty years.
