## Disciple Maker Index

### PARISH SURVEY

In 2018, our Parish Community participated in a Survey entitled the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)**. Our participation in this Survey has borne much fruit for our Parish Community. It led to our partnering with the Catholic Leadership Institute for the past six years as part of their **Next Generation Catholic Parish**. Our parishioners might remember that CLI conducted a self-study for our Parish Community in 2020 and this led to our Parish Community forming an Envisioning Team which met monthly throughout 2022 and into 2023. Their work led to the writing of our **Parish Pastoral Plan** in 2023 and the creation of our **Parish Logo**. One of the fruits of our Parish Pastoral Plan is our **Faith Enrichment Series on the Eucharist** which has been held for the past two years.

It was always envisioned that we would conduct a **follow-up DMI** to ascertain what progress we have made in meeting the spiritual needs of our parishioners. Although the follow up was to be conducted in 2022, at the request of Archbishop Nelson Perez, we were asked to postpone our **DMI** until now so that all the parishes of the Archdiocese could conduct the Survey at the same time.

As we did in 2018, we are asking, indeed encouraging, our parishioners to please participate in the **DMI** by completing a **10-15 minute Survey online**. Shortly, the Survey can be accessed online at [www.disciplemakerindex.com](http://www.disciplemakerindex.com) or in paper form which

will be available at the doors of the church and at the rectory. The Survey will only be **available from March 5th to April 10<sup>th</sup>**. Through the Survey, you will be asked to reflect on your own spiritual growth here at St. Frances Cabrini and thus provide feedback on what efforts the Parish Community has been doing to help you grow spiritually. We ask that all parishioners 18 and older participate. Married couples are asked to complete the Survey individually that is, not as a couple. In other words, married couples would be completing two Surveys. **Please be assured that all responses will be confidential and the Parish will only receive information about the Parish Community as a whole.**

To be helpful, it is important that we get the highest number of responses possible. In 2018, we received **532** responses. This information will be invaluable to me, our Pastoral Staff and our Parish Pastoral Council as we plan for the future of our St. Frances Cabrini Parish and try to be the best disciples we can be. We will receive the results this summer, at which time we will share with the Parish Community what we have learned from the **DMI**. **Please know that we will be receiving an aggregate report of the results and no one will have access to the individual survey responses.**

*Again, if you do not use the internet* – There will be opportunities to complete the Survey after daily and Sunday Mass and you can obtain a paper copy by picking up a copy of the Survey at the doors of the church or by contacting the rectory at 215-946-4040.

*I want to embark on a new form of pastoral planning by asking a new question, "Where does the Church need to be and how?" ... We can do better. I can do better...*

*I want to begin to close this distance between many of our loved ones and the Church. I want people to know that the Lord is still calling them, that they are of great worth, have a divine purpose, and an eternal home...*

*Many times, you may be the only person in a loved one's life who can reach them when they are feeling lost or disconnected. Your encounters can mark the beginning of their return. This is our shared mission: to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ's love, mercy, and resurrection to a world that desperately needs it.*

*Join the conversation & be heard.*

**Jesus teaches us to see others as God sees them.** Though our enemies may mistreat us, Jesus teaches us not to respond in judgment. Rather, we are to be loving and forgiving, just as our Father is kind and merciful. We must see others as God sees them, in the same way that David is able to see his enemy Saul as God's anointed, and Jesus is able to see sinners as worthy of goodness and love.

**1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23**  
**1 Corinthians 15:45-49**  
**Luke 6:27-38**

In the first reading, David spares the life of his enemy Saul, because Saul is God's anointed. In the second reading, Paul speaks of the first man, Adam, from earth and the last Adam, from heaven. He says, "Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one." In the Gospel, Jesus teaches His disciples to love their enemies and be merciful as God is merciful, for they will be treated the same in return.

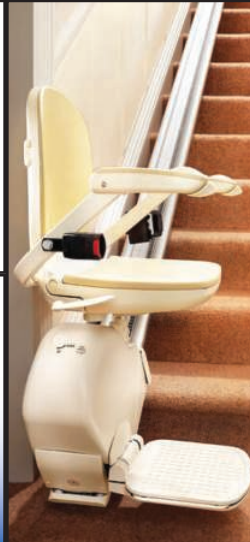
