ARCHBISHOP NELSON J. PÉREZ SENDS LETTER TO THE JEWISH COMMUNITY AT PASSOVER

Dear Friends in the Jewish Faith Community,

In these times of domestic uncertainty and ongoing violence abroad, particularly in the Holy Land, the eight-day commemoration of Pesach is a powerful reminder of the Almighty's mercy. May this commemoration of the Israelites' release from slavery in ancient Egypt provide renewed hope for people of faith in the Philadelphia region and around the world.
