STATEMENT OF MOST REVEREND NELSON J. PÉREZ REGARDING THE EXPLOSION IN BEIRUT, LEBANON

People of good will from around the world have been deeply saddened by the heart wrenching images of utter devastation emanating from Beirut. The explosion that took place on Tuesday in the city's bustling port resulted in unimaginable loss of life and destruction of property.
